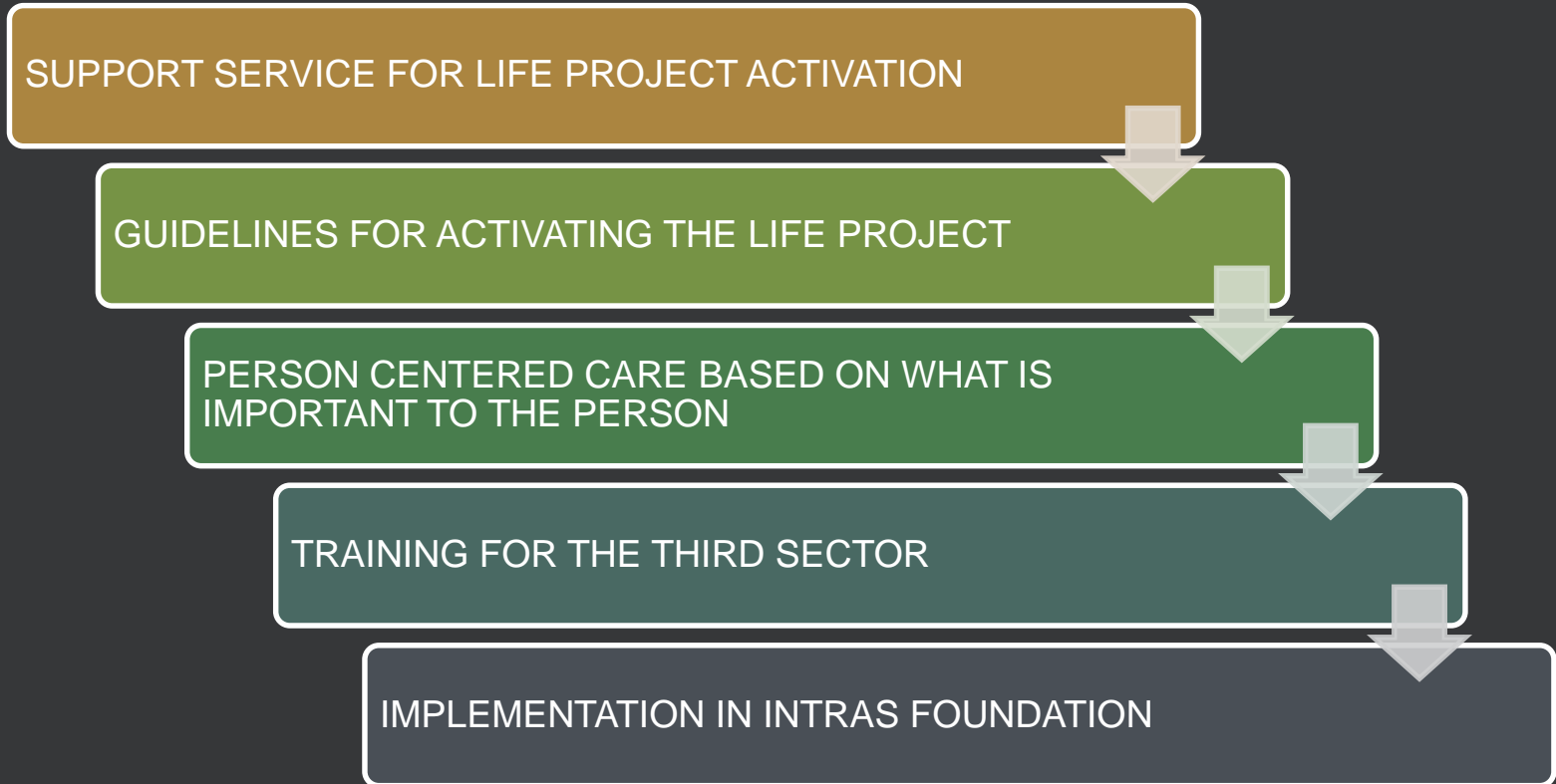


The aim is that all individuals who seek social services receive support and care grounded in their personal interests, values, and what genuinely matters to them.
